### Engaging a Global Force

Susan G. Komen® is the world's largest breast cancer organization, funding more breast cancer research than any other nonprofit while providing real-time help to those facing the disease. Since its founding in 1982, Komen has funded **more than \$988 million in research** and provided **more than \$2.2 billion in funding to screening, education, treatment and psychosocial support programs** serving millions of people in more than 30 countries worldwide. Komen was founded by Nancy G. Brinker, who promised her sister, Susan G. Komen, that she would end the disease that claimed Suzy's life.

### Focused on Local Impact

Through events like the annual Race for the Cure®, Rock the Ribbon, BigWigs and community-based programs like our partnership with Diagnostic Imaging Centers to bring 3D mobile mammography to the community the Kansas & Western Missouri affiliate has invested **more than \$27.5 million in local community breast health programs** and research throughout the US with the national grants program. Up to 75% of net funds generated by the Affiliate stay in the Kansas & Western Missouri region. The remaining 25% supports the Susan G. Komen National Grants Program to fund research.
